ON DRUNK DRIVING THIS HOLIDAY SEASON  
*Annual Holiday DUI Effort Underscores Need For Underage Drinking Prevention Campaign***

PHOENIX – For many families the holidays are a time of celebration and alcohol is often a part of the festivities. The *Draw the Line* campaign applauds law enforcement for ensuring our roads will again be safe this year from drunk drivers, and reminds adults that alcohol is harmful to teens regardless of whether or not they are behind the wheel.
